Long Island has been hard hit by the twin epidemics of HIV/AIDS and substance abuse. Project Safety Net's mission is to reduce the spread of HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis and other STDs in communities across Long Island, especially those in the NYSDOH Community Needs Index as having the highest incidence of HIV infection and substance abuse.

Using a mobile outreach approach, our goal is to provide on-the-spot services to individuals in high-need areas who are not connected to many of the services available in our community. Our outreach team conducts extensive outreach on the streets of targeted neighborhoods via drop-in centers, shelters, soup kitchens, etc...

- Free and confidential rapid HIV counseling and testing.
- Facilitation of Hepatitis C screening.
- Comprehensive Risk Counseling and Services (CRCS).
- Immediate "fast tracking" into substance abuse treatment.
- Immediate "fast tracking" into Case Management.
- On-the-spot education about reducing the risk of HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis and other STDs transmission and the link between substance abuse and HIV.
- Distribution of condoms.
- Referrals to Primary Health Care, Mental Health Treatment, and other Community Based Services.
- Comprehensive Risk Assessments.
